Family Descriptions:

Our first family has been having problems making ends meet since the oil spill last year affected the father's job as a commercial fisherman. Additionally, his wife has medical problems with a type of mitochondria disease. They have five young children ages eight through two years old.

Our second family has also been affected by last year's oil spill. The father was laid off from his job offshore, while the mother has had trouble finding employment. They have three children, ages ranging from five to thirteen.

The third family is a single mother of two, who since separating from her husband in February has experienced financial difficulties. Her and her two sons, age two and nine, have had to move out of their own home and are now sharing a home with her father.
